Our ensemble is from Radeberg, a small town near Dresden (Saxony), and was established in 1968. We bring the joy of music to parades, concerts and historical reenactments with an extensive repertoire including traditional marches, beloved tunes, as well as modern and classical arrangements.

For our musical performances we wear historically-inspired uniforms after the example of the Saxon Infantry Regiment "Prinz Friedrich August" from around 1810. We play the traditional Marching Band instruments flute, snare drum, lyre, cymbals and bass drum.

- 200 year Commemoration of the Anniversary of the Battle of the Nations in Leipzig,
- the Steuben Parade in New York.
- Reenactment of Napoléon & Josephine's wedding in Paris,
